Dear Friend:-

To meet the estimated current expense for 1938, approximately \$ 1,000.00 more will be needed, than has been pledged. We also note, that our 1938 weekly contributions to date, are considerably less than last year. This means an increase in our current expense of about 20 %

Last year \$900.00 was paid off on our church debt, by the special Easter offering, but in reality, it amounted to only \$ 500.00 because it was found necessary to borrow \$400.00 during the balance of the year, therefore nearly \$1,000.00 of the Easter offering was needed to finance the operating expense during 1937

For several years our expense has been fixed; that is, there have been no increases in salaries or fixed operating expenses. Our regular giving has fallen off however, due in large part to deaths of many of our older and most loyal members. Surely we should feel our responsibility in simply maintaining the church home, which by their earlier hard work and sacrifices they provided and made possible for us to enjoy.

As property and equipment become older, maintenance and repairs increase likewise. That, in large part, accounts for the budget increase this year, on estimated repairs to the church, parsonage and organ equipment.

In view of this, you can readily see the need of and the reason for, this direct appeal to you. We feel that knowing this, your response as individual members of organizations and friends of Emanuel, will be 100% and that no further solicitation will be necessary, so that the committee may devote its time to other work. This Easter offering shall be a special gift, and not take the place of your weekly contribution.

The amount to be given represents or averages only a few dollars per individual, which is but a small sacrifice during this Lenten season. A few cents laid aside daily between now and Easter will make every one a Contributor toward a successful goal.

It is hoped, that as loyal members and friends, in 1939 we will increase the amount of our regular weekly giving and feel our individual responsibility in more regular church attendance and support of the church work, so that no direct appeal will be necessary again.

We hope by your response, the committee's judgment has been correct in the belief, that if the needs of the church were presented you, as outlined, the need for personal calls, taking your time and ours, is not necessary.

Please note, that only one letter is sent to each home, therefore we suggest you discuss this at your dinner table tonight.

Sincere thanks in doing your part toward attaining \$1,000.00 for Easter.

N accurate and comprehensive Church Register, is of paramount importance.

The design of this Register is to supply a long felt want for an orderly, succinct and systematic record of all matters pertaining to the annual growth, activity and history of a congregation in the briefest manner possible.

It is arranged alphabetically or with numbers as desired.

The arrangement of the records and statistical tables is well adapted to the use of almost any congregation, with but little modification, and covers nearly every possible contingency.

When the alphabetical order is used the family relations can be determined by reference to the Baptismal record. If, on the other hand, the numerical system is followed the children's numbers must correspond with the parent's numbers throughout the Register.

The spacing for the various items of the records is ample, when using figures to represent days, months and years.

The letters "M." and "S." in the Marriage record, indicate married or single.

The special parochial and statistical tables are inserted for permanent record and convenient reference as indexes of the growth of the congregation.

With the hope that it will subserve the purpose for which it is designed—this Register is respectfully submitted to the Church at large.

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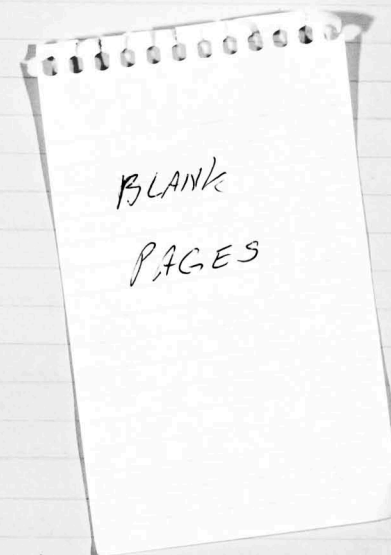

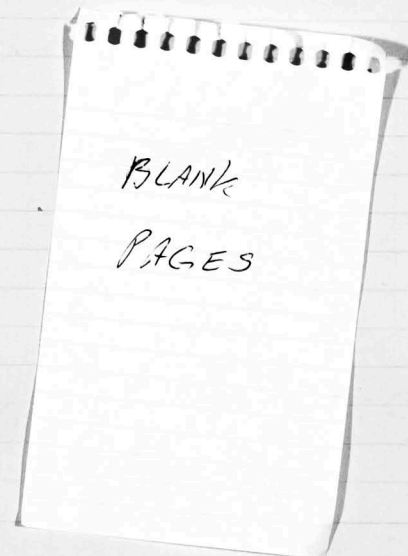

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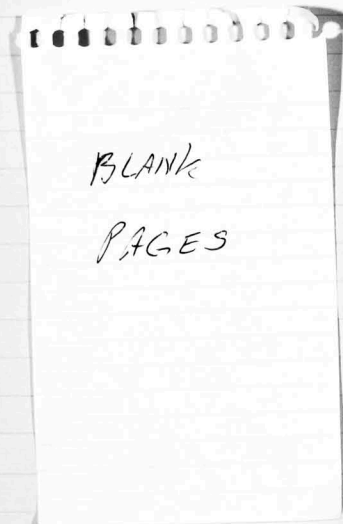
