# Grace, Christ Lutheran Churches Consolidation

Grace Lutheran Church on Clifford Avenue and Christ Lutheran Church on Central Park have decided to merge.

The decision came after the retirement in June of the Rev. Paul R. Hoover, who

was pastor of Grace Lutheran for 25 years.

While the consolidation is yet to be legally completed, the two congregations have been worshipping together

while refurbishing the Grace Lutheran building.

The Rev. Herbert S. Hinman, pastor of Christ Lutheran, says that the seating arrangements and altar placement have been reversed. A new altar has been installed and a nine-foot oak-and-tile cross has been suspended from the ceiling.

Most of the work has been done by volunteers.

A formal service of rededication and consolidation has been scheduled for Nov. 20.
