


Thomas Robertson, U.S. Navy, Seabees (age 16) - October 6, 1944 - June 28, 1946








Walter Campbell, age 17 USNR - active duty July 1, 1944 - July 11, 1946

## Church Memorializes Corporal Semmler

A service of dedication in memory of Corporal David Albert Semmler took place in the Immanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church on Sunday, October 31. Corporal Semmler was killed in action in Viet Nam on February 5, 1971.

The sanctuary light and processional cross were dedicated in his memory. Throughout his life, Corporal Semmler, son of Mr. and Mrs. Albert F. Semmler of Hatch Road was a member of the Lutheran Church.

Born in Victor, Corporal Semmler lived in Rochester before moving to Hatch Road, in Penfield. He was a graduate of R. L. Thomas, class of 1966, a student at Akron University, Akron, Chio, Rochester Business Institute and Rochester Institute of Technology.

He entered the Army in June, 1970 and served in the infantry. He received the Purple Heart, the Bronze Star, the Infantry badge and four marksmen badges. A citation by President Richard Nixon presented posthumously stated, "H is initiative, zeal, sound judgment and devotion to duty have been in the highest tradition of the United States Army and reflected great credit on himself, his unit and military service."


