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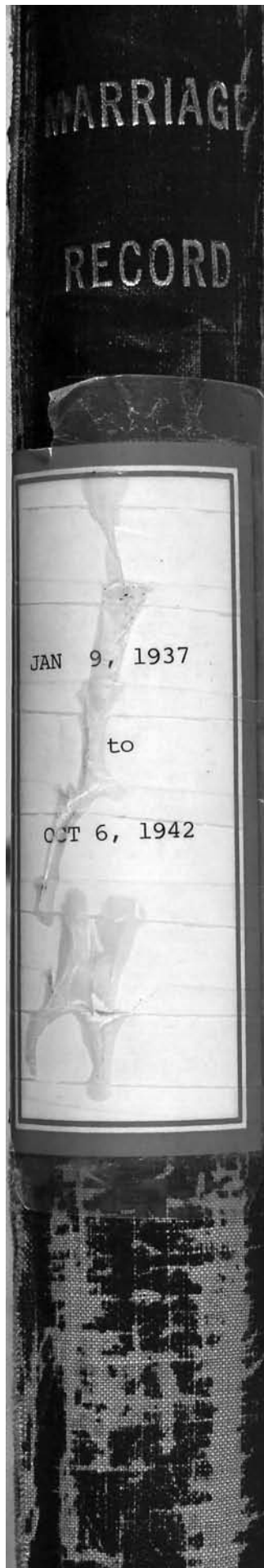
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CHILD MARRIAGES NOT RARE IN NATION

But 1930 Census Showed a Decline to 4,241 Wives Under 15 From 5,554 in 1920

FEW BOYS MARRY YOUNG

Legal Age in Fourteen States Has Been 14 Years for Them and 12 for Girls

WASHINGTON, Feb. 6.—Inquiries inspired by the recent marriages of a 9-year-old Tennessee girl and a 12-year-old New York girl reveal that child marriages are more common in the United States than generally supposed.

Detailed information is lacking, but, in so far as can be determined, Eunice Winstead Brown, the recent Tennessee mountain child bride, is the youngest native American to be married in the history of marital statistics.

The Census Bureau records as of April 1, 1930, showed 4,241 married girls under 15 years of age. This represented a sharp reduction from the total of 5,554 at the time of the 1920 census.

Small Ratio of Total

The number of married girls under 15 is only about two-hundredths of 1 per cent of the total population of girls of this age.

Instances of married boys under 15 years of age are relatively few, the 1930 census recording a total of 781, or four one-hundred-thousandths of 1 per cent of the entire population of males under 15.

"Child Marriages," by Mary E. Richmond and Fred S. Hall (New York: The Russell Sage Foundation) states that the legal minimum marriageable age a dozen years ago was 14 for boys and 12 for girls in fourteen States (Kentucky, Louisiana, Virginia, Florida, Maine, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Colorado, Idaho, Maryland, Mississippi, New Jersey and New York).

The authors report that there are parts of the modern world—India, especially—where it would be exceptional to find an unmarried female child over the age of puberty.

"We have found wide gaps," declare the investigators, "between the intent of the laws relating to youthful marriage and their actual administrative results, and have found some legislators, some administrators and some clergymen who are still convinced that any girl arrived at the age of puberty is ready for marriage."

It is the conclusion of these writers that early marriage is injurious to the general health, and that "it is not difficult to understand how, if this is so, the reproductive functions would be adversely affected."

The authors assert that "the weight of evidence is all against marriage for either sex at puberty; against marriage of girls under 16 and, on the whole, for marriage of girls under 18 and boys under 20."

The book offers some comment on conditions in the area of the extraordinary Tennessee marriage.

Some Factors Suggested

"The Southern highlands of the United States," it says, "furnish good illustration of the relation between climate, geography and youthful marriage. Their altitude, if this were the only factor to be considered, would tend to delay marriage. But wherever we find natural barriers to intercommunity and towns and villages isolated by those barriers, we are likely to find youthful marriages."

"These are due in large part to the difficulty of communication with an outside world which has more varied pleasures and occupations."

gator reports, and "there is little comfort for the spinster, relegated to the hard task of life, yet dependent for support upon her male and married woman kindred, all of whom are agreed in thinking her a failure."

Parental consent makes possible many marriages which otherwise would be impossible. In fact, even the most cautious license officials sometimes are unable to refuse legal authorization of a marriage because the prospective bride and bridegroom meet the age requirements, however low, and have parental blessing from one side or the other or both.

Of 240 child marriages studied by Miss Richmond and Mr. Hall in detail, 109 were contracted with parental consent, and in 30 of these the children were so young that the issuance of a license was illegal, parental approval notwithstanding.

Father of 92 Awaits 38th Child

BROOKSVILLE, Fla., Feb. 6 (AP).

Ambrose Hillard Douglas, a Negro 82 years old and the father of thirty-seven children, told the Board of Social Welfare today that the thirty-eighth was on the way. The Welfare Board will give the baby, the thirteenth by Douglas's present wife, a complete layette. Douglas lives in a little house north of Brooksville with his wife and eleven of his children, ranging from 37 months to 15 years. The father has a job with the WPA that pays him \$19 a month, an income he supplements by selling Spanish moss. He was born in North Carolina on May 5, 1845.

Marriage Fees Change by Day in the Netherlands

The Hague.—The day of the week has a lot to do with getting married here. There are different prices for different days.

The rates run from gratis at 9 a. m. on Wednesdays in groups, to 100 florin on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Mondays cost 75 florin, Tuesdays 100, Wednesdays at 9 a. m. free, later in the day in groups, 7.50 florin and, individually, 15, Thursday is another 100 florin day, but on Friday it is possible to be married in groups for 12.50 florins each. Saturdays cost 75 florin.

LAW REQUIRES DISEASE TESTS

Albany—(AP)—New York, furthering its war against syphilis, yesterday became the ninth state to ban the marriage of persons infected with the disease in a communicable stage.

Governor Lehman's signature put on the statute books, effective July 1, a law prohibiting issuance of a marriage license unless the prospective bride and groom submit to a serological blood test and present evidence showing they have not contracted syphilis or so, not in a communicable stage.

his marriage another step in New York's fight against syphilis," the Democratic executive said.

Only a few weeks before, the Governor approved legislation requiring prospective mothers to undergo serological tests for the disease in an effort to reduce infant mortality.

Pre-marital examinations and blood tests also are compulsory in Connecticut, Illinois, New Hampshire, New Jersey, Kentucky, Rhode Island, Michigan and Wisconsin.

The law stipulates that the examination and blood test must be made not more than 30 days preceding application for a license, and that the ceremony must be performed within 60 days after it is granted.

Must File Results

Results of the examination and test must be filed by a physician with local health authorities, who are required to hold the information in "absolute confidence" except to produce it for evidence at a trial upon court order. Misrepresentation of facts by physicians, laboratory representatives or licensing officers is made a misdemeanor.

Requirements of the law may be waived "because of emergency or other cause shown by affidavits of justice, county judge or, if a woman, is between 14 and 16, by a children's court judge."

New York health authorities estimated approximately 30,000 new cases of syphilis in the state each year, with 1,200,267 children born in 1937 were infected with the disease, they added.

Marriages in 1939

That the marriage rate mirrors important economic changes in the life of people is a fact of general knowledge. A serious economic depression invariably results in a drop in the rate; increased opportunities for employment move the rate upward. A well-publicized Gretna Green may, however, nullify the influence of depressing economic forces. Any one interested in the trend of the marriage rate of a single state must, therefore, consider not only business conditions but also the character of local legislation.

For many years considerable numbers of impatient couples came to this State to be married because of the comparative leniency of our Domestic Relations Law. In upstate New York the proportion of such marriages steadily increased to a maximum of 34 per cent in 1936. The enactment in that year of the three-day waiting law resulted in a sharp decrease in nonresident marriages, and the added weight of the premarital test for syphilis, which became effective July 1, 1938, has now made the contribution of nonresidents a factor of very minor numerical importance. In 1939, only 1711 nonresidents were married in the State, exclusive of New York City.

as compared with 4493 in the preceding year, 17,493 in 1937, and 23,521 in 1936.

The number of resident marriages has also been affected by these two laws, but to a much smaller extent. The influence of the three-day waiting law has been rather slight because all states bordering on New York had already provided for such a period to precede or to follow the issuance of a marriage license. The "blood-test" law undoubtedly impelled many New York couples to be married in other states; there is evidence, however, that this movement has practically ceased. Beginning July, the monthly number of resident marriages in upstate New York in 1939 was greater than in 1938, and as a result the entire year showed a slight increase—from 39,991 to 40,821 marriages.

No More Marriage in Hastel

Less repentance, may we not hope, at leisure! New York State's new law passed to prevent runaway marriages evidently has teeth and good ones.

Records tabulated by the Department's Division of Vital Statistics, J. V. DePorte, Ph.D., director, show that during September there were 1656 fewer marriages in upstate New York than in the corresponding month of 1936—a drop from 7847 to 6191. This decrease, in Doctor DePorte's opinion, may be accounted for by a marked reduction in the number of marriages of non-residents, resulting from the operation of an amendment to the Domestic Relations Law which became effective September 1 of the present year. This new

law provides that "a marriage shall not be solemnized within seventy-two hours from the date and hour of issuance of the marriage license therefor, unless authorized by an order of a court of record." It was enacted by the 1937 legislature as a result of public recognition of the wisdom of requiring that a reasonable interval of time elapse between the application for a license and the solemnization of a marriage. The highly publicized frequency of so-called "gin marriages" undoubtedly helped to bring about unanimity of opinion in favor of such a measure.

Because of the comparative leniency of the Domestic Relations Law of this State, the number of marriages of nonresidents has been increasing from year to year. In upstate New York, marriages in which the bride was a nonresident of the State amounted in 1926 to 12 per cent of all marriages; in 1936, the proportion had risen to 34 per cent. Most of these marriages occurred in the counties adjacent to the neighboring states of Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Ohio. Incidentally, all of these states already had a statutory provision for a waiting period to precede or to follow the issuance of a marriage license.

Although information regarding the residence of the persons married last September is not yet available, a consideration of the figures for the counties in which the number of nonresidents has been highest leads to the conclusion that all of the reduction has occurred among the latter group:

The total number of marriages recorded in the nine counties in September 1936 was 3217, while in September of this year the number dropped to 1486—a difference of 1731, which was greater than the reduction in the entire upstate territory.

Marriages in 1940 6/16/41

There were more marriages in 1940 in the State, exclusive of New York City, in which the bride was a resident of that area than in any other year. Compared with 1939, the 52,000 marriages recorded last year represent an increase of 27 per cent. The previous high annual total was 48,500 in 1937. In the first half of the twenty-year period 1920-1940 the annual number of resident marriages fluctuated from year to year without exhibiting any definite trend. The economic depression, the inception of which was characterized by the financial crash in the fall of 1929, was reflected in a sustained drop in marriages which reached a minimum just under 33,000 in 1932. Beginning with 1933 the trend was reversed.

In 1938 the number of resident marriages decreased by more than 8,000. This was a direct consequence of the legal provisions for a seventy-two-hour waiting period between the issuance of the license and the solemnization of the marriage (which became effective September 1, 1937), and for a premarital blood test for syphilis (effective July 1, 1938). The deterrent effect of this legislation apparently persisted for a few months because in the last half of 1939 there was a marked increase in resident marriages, and the total for the year was somewhat higher than that of the year before. The increase in the number of marriages in 1940, proportionately the greatest on record, represents in large measure the impetus given by the Selective Service Act to the immediate consummation of many contemplated marriages. It is undoubtedly this factor which accounted for an increase of 45 per cent in the marriages in August, 1940, as compared with the same month of 1939, a 41 per cent increase in September, and a 50 per cent increase in October. The disparity between the 1940 and 1939 figures dropped to 20 per cent in November, and to less than 2 per cent in December.
