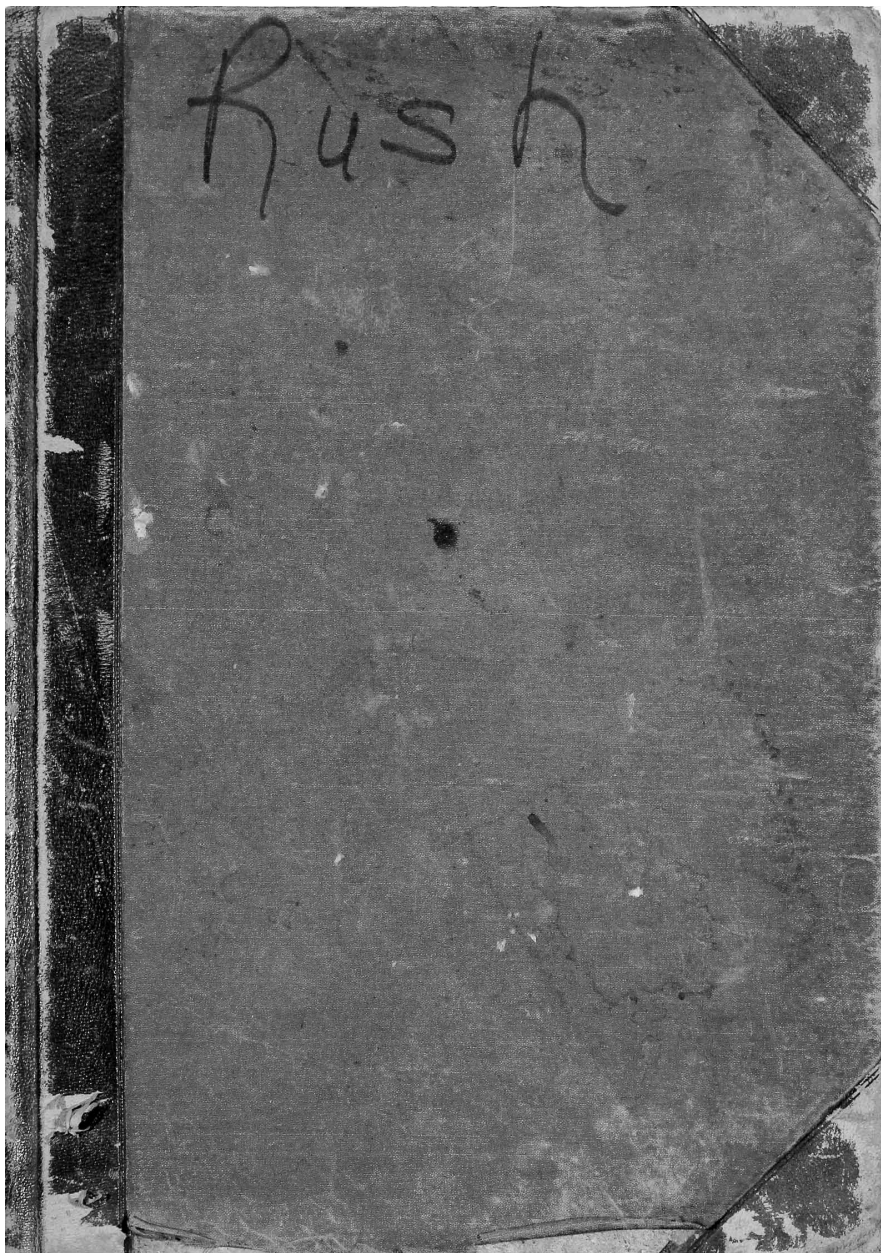

## Introduction.

---

THE Discipline of our Church makes it the duty of Presiding Elders, in conducting the business of their respective Quarterly Conferences, to inquire, among other things, "Are the Church Records properly kept?" And, as an index of what should be contained in those records, it requires the Stewards "to record the Marriages and Baptisms," and the Preacher in Charge of a Circuit or Station "to take a regular catalogue of the Societies in towns and cities as they occur in the streets, and to leave his successor a particular account of the Circuit or Station" which he has been serving.

The importance of keeping these records correctly and neatly cannot be overestimated; and any Pastor who, through carelessness, fails to do so is highly culpable, and deserves the censure of his Conference.

From a somewhat extended examination of the matter we find that this duty has in some instances been neglected, while in others it has been performed in an exceedingly indifferent manner—the records of some Churches, even in our largest cities, often embracing nothing more than a simple list of the names of the members of the several classes, without any indication as to what is their state in life, their position in the Church, or their place of residence.

This delinquency has doubtless resulted in part from the fact that, until within a few years, no regular Church Record was published for the use of our Societies, and every Pastor was left to keep his record in his own way, and in such books as he could command at the time. As might be expected, this gave the Church a few records of respectable dimensions, kept in every variety of form; but it more generally produced nothing but small, unsightly, unsubstantial books, which were used for a season, and then thrown aside as useless. And thus much of the early history of our Churches has been irrecoverably lost.

To supply this great want of the Church, and give regularity and uniformity to our records, the Book Concern, some years since, published a Church Record which has been in use, to a greater or less extent, from that time till the present. But experience, and the progress of the Church, have shown that this is defective, both as to its contents and arrangement. Other departments are required, and provision for additional items are needed. Moreover, the different departments of the book are disproportioned in size, one often being entirely filled up before another of equal dimensions is scarcely commenced.

Having ascertained that these defects were injuring the sale of the book, and causing a variety of badly arranged Records to be substituted for it, and receiving, in the mean while, from brethren in different parts of our work, communications expressing a desire for an improved Record, accompanied by brief drafts of such as would suit their views, the publishers had determined to prepare a Record of their own, combining the excellencies of all the plans submitted, and such other items as their own experience and observation might suggest.



But before completing their plans they learned that the Philadelphia Conference, at its late session, had appointed Revs. J. B. McCullough, A. Rittenhouse, and J. B. Dennison a committee, to prepare specimens of an improved Record, to be submitted to the Conference at its next session, and, if approved by it, forwarded to the General Conference for adoption.

On inspecting the specimens prepared by this committee, the publishers found that they were more complete than any other that had been submitted, and contained several important items not in their own draft. But on the whole they were thought to be too elaborate for ordinary use, requiring more entries than most ministers would be willing to make, and withal making the work too expensive for most Churches.

To harmonize all views we invited the chairman of the above-named committee to meet us at our office, to which he kindly assented. The whole field was carefully surveyed, the different points of interest thoroughly canvassed, and the plans for the present volume drawn out.

The Record thus prepared, as will be seen by examination, contains *nine* departments, which are arranged in the following order, namely:

- I. HISTORICAL RECORD.
- II. PROBATIONERS' RECORD.
- III. CLASS RECORDS.
- IV. ALPHABETICAL RECORD OF MEMBERS IN FULL CONNECTION.
- V. CHRONOLOGICAL RECORD OF OFFICIAL MEMBERS.
- VI. PASTORAL AND STATISTICAL RECORD.
- VII. RECORD OF BAPTISMS.
- VIII. RECORD OF MARRIAGES.
- IX. APPENDIX.

The manner of using these different departments will be fully explained on the title-page of each respectively.

The Record will be bound up in two or three different sizes, so as to meet the wants of Churches of every grade, from a membership of one hundred to a thousand. Each book, however, will embrace all the departments, and retain the relative proportion of the several parts.

By the use of this book we shall have uniformity in our Records throughout our entire work, so that a minister having learned the manner of keeping them in one charge will be prepared to keep them properly in any other charge to which he may be sent.

Hoping that this effort may give general satisfaction and lead to a better system of Church book-keeping, we commend this volume to the favorable consideration of those for whose use it has been provided.

# HISTORICAL RECORD.

## EXPLANATIONS AND DIRECTIONS.

This department is intended to contain a brief record of everything of importance connected with the history of the Church using it. If an old Church, then a brief history of its organization, and of its difficulties and successes, etc., should be entered first, embracing from five to ten pages. After that, each Pastor will be expected to add a page or two at the end of the Conference year, giving a brief account of such matters in connection with the Church as he may deem of sufficient importance to be preserved among its records. Brief obituary notices of distinguished members may be inserted, provided the entire record of the year does not exceed two pages closely written.

## Historical Record.

Proposed

In the early part of this <sup>Conf.</sup> year 1867-8 the attention of the Official Members of the Rush Church was called by the Pastor in the Leaders Meetings to the expediency of purchasing the Improved Church Record published at the Methodist Book Concern N.Y.

Again in answer to the Disciplinary Question viz. "Are the Church Records properly kept" asked by the Presiding Elder in the first Quarterly Meeting Conference of the year which was held in East Rush Nov. 10th. 1867 the same subject was referred to by the Pastor. Furthermore the importance of such a Record to furnish a neat and correct Register of Membership as well as a permanent place for the record of current events constituting church history increasing in value with the increase of years of years was strongly set forth &c in the above named Quarterly Conference by the Presiding Elder Rev. John Dennis.

He also alluded to the fact that in the old Record used for many years there are items of Methodist history pertaining to this locality that are worthy of preservation in the best and most permanent form. There was no special action of the L. Conf. on the subject but the remarks seem to have forcibly impressed Dr. Josias Smith and resulted in a generous resolve on his part.

Accordingly on the evening of the National Thanksgiving Nov. 28th. 1867 the Dr. handed his pastor five Dollars to purchase this book.

Herein it is designed shall be kept a still more exact History and Record of the M. E. Church in Rush from the commencement of A.D. 1868.

May that history be such as shall honor God and be reviewed with pleasure by his people through all the succeeding generations.

the scarcity of the records and disconnected reports  
which they have been enabled to collect

It is not known when or who first intro-  
duced Methodism into the bounds of what is now  
called Henrietta and Rush Circuit

By inquiry it appears that Palmer Roberts  
first preached at Mr. Covey's now West Henrietta at  
which place a Society was soon after formed which  
in process of time was dissolved and one formed at  
the Methodist Hill. All that is known of the Society  
of East Henrietta is its existence in the year 1822 and  
its subsequent history

The Society on the River road was formed about 1830

There have been Societies existing in the South part  
of the Town of Rush but when they were formed and  
of whom they were composed no records remain to show

1844 At the Conference held in the village of Vienna,  
in the Town of Phelps, Rev. John Wanderville was  
appointed to Rush, and labored here two years.

These were years of prosperity to the church  
in Rush as an extensive revival gathered in many  
valuable families thus increasing her religious and  
financial strength It was during the first year  
of this pastorate that the first M. E. Church ed-  
ifice, which was commenced by Rev. Saml. Parker,  
was dedicated.

1846 At the Conf. held in Lyons Rev Samuel Suckey  
succeeded Rev. J. B. Moulson as P. C.

Rev. A. S. Fillmore appointed Pastor at Rush

1847 Rev. Porter M. Winslow was appointed to Rush

1848 Rev. T. V. Willard pastor at Rush

1849 Rev. T. V. Willard at the Conf. in Elmira was ap-

(During this Conf. year a revival shower re-

by fire. Immediate steps were taken to rebuild,  
which work was commenced in the following spring  
and completed in the winter succeeding.

- A review of these years is both painful and pleasant, painful because we cannot  
be able to do more for the Master and his cause, pleasant because of so much of God's  
grace and blessing received and because of the measure of success attained!
- We came three years ago with a shattered nervous system and have found it impracticable  
for this and other reasons to devote the time we have desired to pastoral visiting.
- We found the Church suffering from the effects of variance between its members in ten  
years, manifest 1<sup>st</sup> in a want of real earnest sympathy among themselves and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the  
indifference of the outsiders generally who looked upon the Church as a sinking institution  
whose extinction was only a question of time x
- The first year passed quite pleasantly but without any decided or striking change in affairs  
but during the early part of the second year a precious work of grace was enjoyed in which  
nearly numbers were converted. Bros Samuel Ely and David Goodrich of First St  
Church also Bro P. B. Smith of First St Church were efficient in this work.
- On the evening of March 1875 a meeting of the official members was held to take

1879-81.

At the fifty-sixth Session of General Conf. held in Delaware Ave. Church, Buffalo, N. Y. we were first appointed to Rush Charge - Rev. John H. Brown, P. E. At the next Conf. Session held at Hornellsville, N. Y. we were re-appointed - Rev. J. T. Gracy, P. E.

At the next Session, held in Bradford, Pa., Oct. 5-11 we were unexpectedly removed, & appointed to New York Charge on the Niagara Dist. - Rev. J. T. Gracy, P. E. of Rochester Dist. *What are the Mysteries of the Cabinet!* On coming to Rush we found a hearty, cordial Society & Congregation - a good Church property, and plenty of work.

Preaching at West Rush (which was discontinued because of the ill-health of our predecessor) was resumed & continued during the two years, once in four weeks & part of the time once in two weeks. We judge that our labor <sup>there</sup> has not been in vain.

During the winter of 1880 special meetings were held which resulted in a slight awakening of the Church.

We take great pleasure in recording the kindness of the Charge in granting their pastor leave of absence to attend General Wesleyan Seminary at Lima, N. Y., which he did during the Spring & Fall terms of '80. A failure of strength was the only reason their generosity was not further accepted.

Thanking our Father for his kindness & long-suffering husband & praying that he will overcome all errors & bless all efforts to the good of his Church, we pass the work over to our successor, earnestly hoping that the Divine blessing may attend him & his beloved people.

### EXPLANATIONS AND DIRECTIONS.

THE headings in this department need little explanation. The double rulings under "State in Life" are designed for a second insertion in case that state is changed during probationship. In the double rulings under the headings, "When and How Baptized," and "When and How disposed of," the first column is to contain the date, and the second the answer to the "How." This in the last column ought to be explicit, as to whether the parties have been *Received into Full Membership*, have *Removed*, have been *Dropped*, have *Withdrawn*, or have *Died*. Care should be taken in receiving Probationers not only to get the names and the classes they propose joining, but also the residence, the state in life, and the fact as to their being baptized or not.

The names of Probationers should not be entered upon the Alphabetical Record of Members until formally received into full connection by the Pastor.

After the first list is made out, the Officers' Names will appear in the order of their appointment without regard to the Office held. Whenever one ceases to be an officer of the Church the proper record should be made as to the time of the removal and the manner, whether by *Expiration of Term*, *Resignation*, *Removal from the Church*, *Death*, or *Expulsion*. The fact of his removal may also be indicated by placing in advance of the name a check mark (✓) in red ink.

This Record, as well as all the others, should be carefully kept. It is not to be rewritten in this book.

---

Each item here enumerated should be carefully entered, as, in the case of orphan children, the Baptismal Record is often the only means by which they could prove either their age or their parentage.

When adults are baptized, the *Names of Parents* and the *Dates of Birth* may be omitted, except it be in the case of very young persons, who can have no delicacy in giving the necessary information. The Mode of Baptism, though well-nigh uniform in our Church, may be specified as an item of interest in the future. Under the head of *Remarks* may be entered anything in connection with said baptisms that the minister may deem sufficiently important to notice. In entering the Date of the Baptism in the double column on the left, it will add to the appearance of the Record to put the year on the margin, and the month and day in the next column, thus: 1863 | Dec. 25, | instead of Dec. 25, 1863. As the year will not be repeated so frequently, it will leave a wider and neater margin.

# Appendix.

"Copy of codicil of Bequest to Methodist Episcopal Church East-Rush. Monroe Co. N.Y."

"I give & bequeath to the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church in East-Rush. One Thousand Dollars to be paid to them or their successors in office one year after my decease to be kept safely & permanently invested by them & the interest thereof to be paid as follows viz: Fifty Dollars for or towards the Methodist or Preachers claim of said church at said Village, Ten Dollars for the Sunday School purposes attached to said church at that place, & the remainder of the interest for what is called the Fifth-Collection for Supersubstituted preachers - to be paid annually or semi-annually as said interest may be due or rec<sup>d</sup>, but no part of the principal is to be used & it is my intention that the said trustees & their successors in office shall be personally liable for the safe keeping & investment of said principal & the payment of said interest. & it is my further will & intention that in case of failure to keep up & sustain Methodist preaching at that place or a Sunday School attached to said church at that place that the interest or amount that would be going to that or payable (which ever should fail) shall be paid to said supersubstituted claim."
