M E Church History Town of Rush

A Methodist Episcopal Society was first formed in the Town of Rush in 1830 at Still Corners, 1 1/2 miles west of E. Rush village. Trustees were chosen & Feb 4-1832 a plot of land was bought at the corners upon which a stone church was built & dedicated the same year. Meetings were held ^{in this church} until 1847. During the Pastorate of the Rev Samuel Parker in 1844, a Society was formed & Church established ^{at} ~~in the village of~~ ^{place} East Rush. To which the Society at Still Corners were ~~subsequently~~ ^{by degrees} gradually transferred. The Society at E. Rush was organized & Trustees elected Feb 19-1844 & was named "The First Methodist Episcopal Church in the village of East Rush" a lot was purchased in

village for which '650 was paid upon which a house of worship & a Parsonage was built. In the fall of 1841 Rev John Manderville was assigned the charge & under his supervision the Church begun at E Rush was finished & dedicated.

In 1850 the Church & parsonage at E Rush was burned. The Society at once set to work to rebuild & in Feb 1852 a new Church was dedicated the cost of which including a Bell was \$400.

~~Pastor in charge at this time was John Parker. The same year the Society purchased a parsonage in the village adjoining the Public School lot for which \$500 was paid. (In 1865 some repairs were made on the Church at East Rush Coal Store & a Chancel were purchased.)~~

In 1878 Rev J D DuBois Pastor. The Church at Rush was remodelled & enlarged & repainted at a cost of about \$2400.

At this time a furnace was substituted for stoves in heating the Audinon Room.

1889 Rev W J West Pastor. A new Parsonage House & Barn was built at E Rush at a cost of about \$2700 on the west half of the Parsonage lot. The east half being sold for \$200. At this time the Stone Church at Still Corners was torn down and the material used in building the new Parsonage. The plot of ground upon which it stood was sold for \$50.

Aug 9 - 1892 The Church at East Rush ^{again} was destroyed by fire. ^{At a meeting} It was decided to change site & through the efforts of the Pastor Rev R H Kipland the site was sold for \$1200 & new site purchased at the same price opposite the new parsonage. The sale and purchase was completed.
