


Welcome to Salem!



You are invited to enjoy some of Salem's most beautiful treasures: the German Art Glass stained glass windows that grace our sanctuary. Most of these windows were installed in our between 1906 and 1909, given in mem-

sanctuary between 1906 and 1909, given in memory of loved ones.

The windows were given to tell a story: they illumine favorite passages from scripture. These windows do more than just *tell* the story, however. They invite us in. They invite us to place ourselves at Jesus' feet, or in the arms of the shepherd, to sit on the hillside with the shepherd David or enter Jacob's dream. They invite us take our own journey of faith and to meditate on the presence of God's love and action in our own lives.

Though these windows are rich in history, they are testimony to the truth that God is still speaking.

So come in, begin the tour, and allow the Spirit of God to touch your heart today.

Begin the tour: The tour begins in the front of the sanctuary, on the side near the organ. Follow along the side of the church, through the narthex, and then back around the other side. Then make your way to the balcony and tour the second floor windows following the same direction as the first floor.

Christ in Gethsemane

Then Jesus went with them to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, "Sit here, while I go yonder and pray." *Matthew* 26-36

Christ Blessing the Children

Then little children were being brought to him in order that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples spoke sternly to those who brought them; but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs. And he laid his hands on them and went on his way. *Matthew 19:1-15*

Easter Morning

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in, they did not find the body. While they were perplexed about this, suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them. The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living

among the dead? He is not here, but has risen." Luke 24:1-5

The Feeding of the Multitudes

Then he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish, he looked up to heaven, and blessed and broke the

loaves, and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And all ate and were filled; and they took up what was left over of the broken pieces, twelve baskets full. And



those who ate were about five thousand men, besides women and children. Matthew 15:19-21
