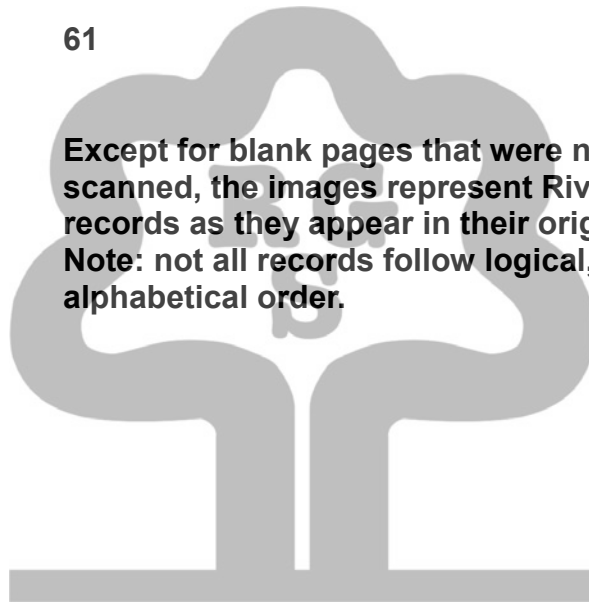

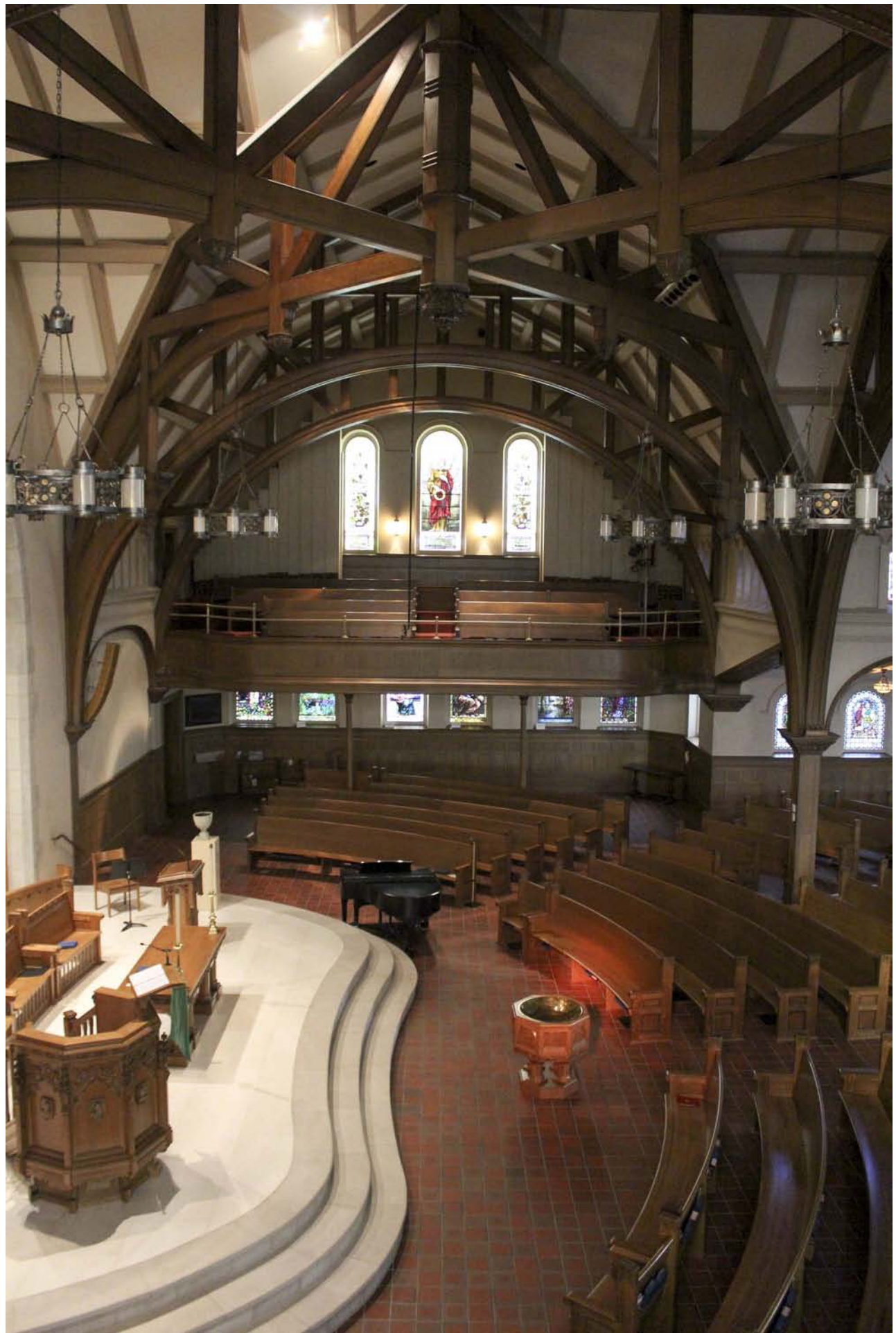

in the 42^d year of his age.

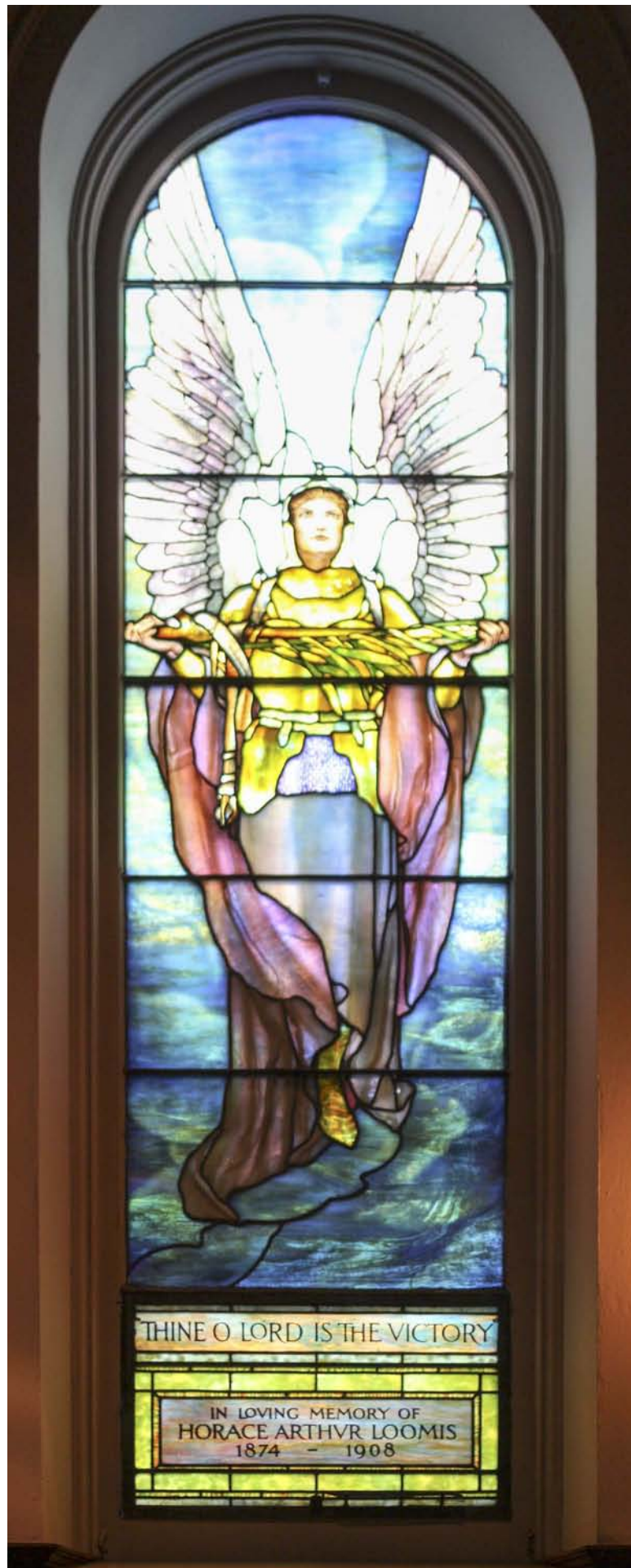
He was seventeen years an Elder in this church, thirty six years connected with the Sabbath School, six years as its Superintendent.

"He being dead-yet speaketh."



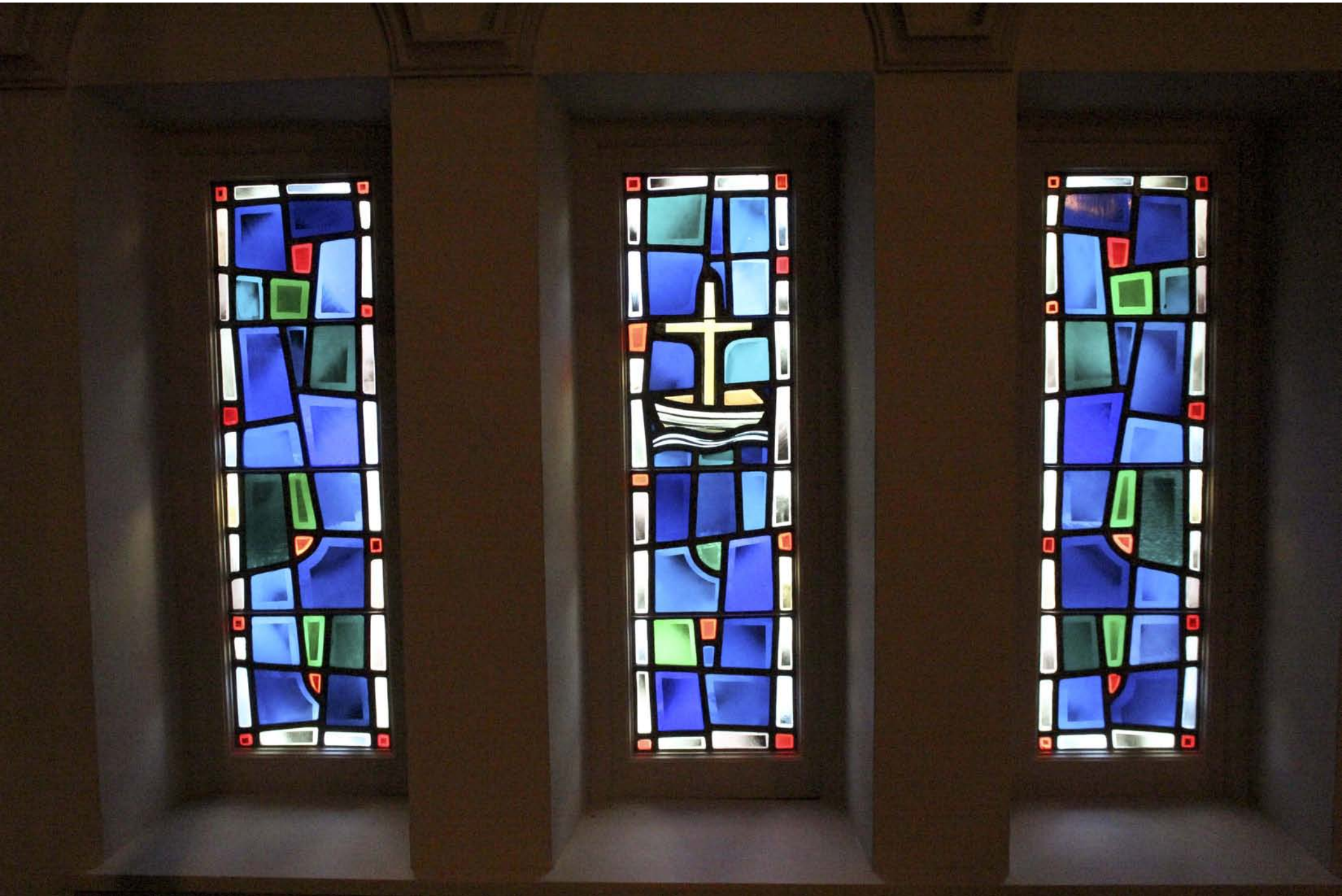




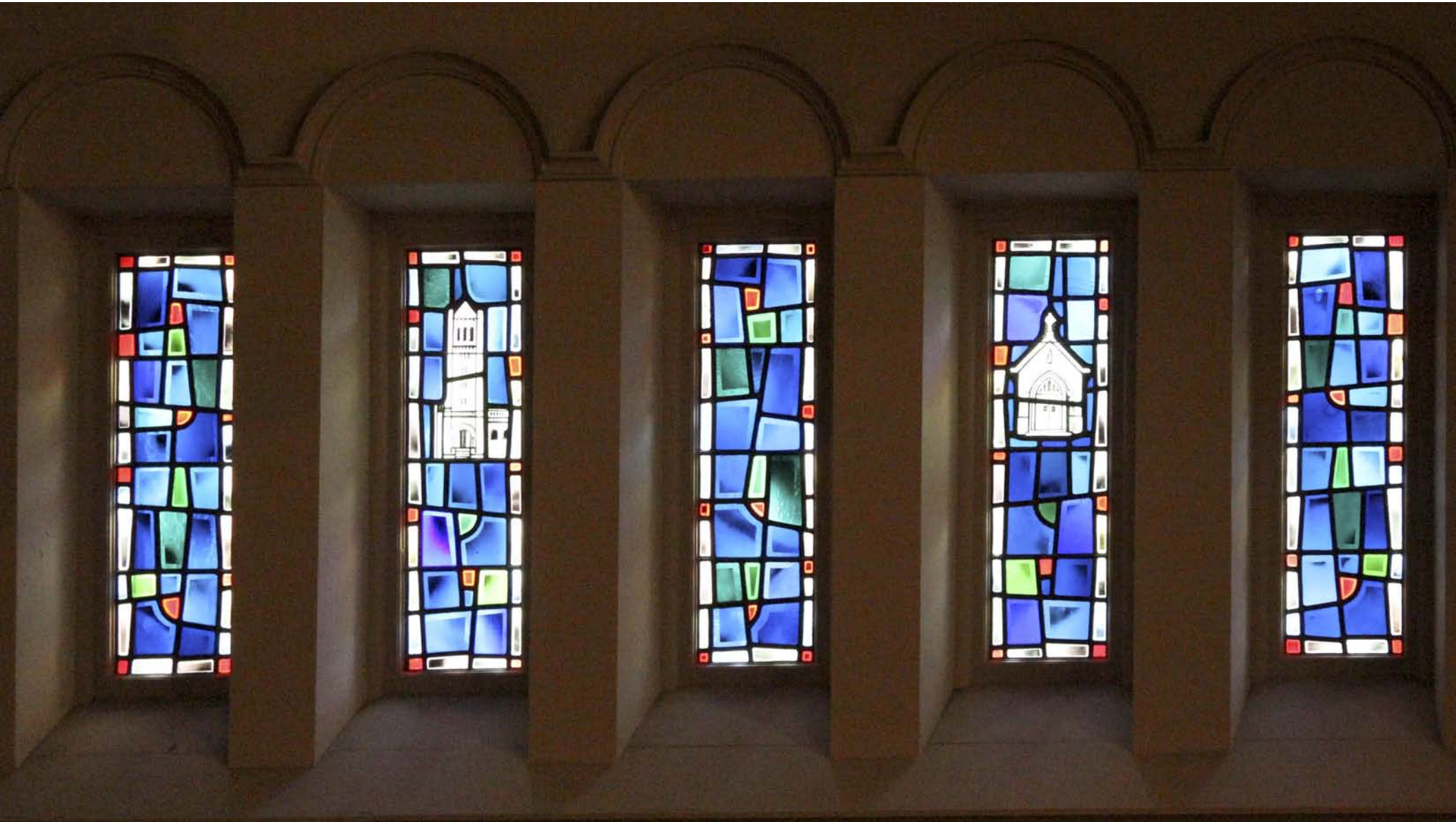
